



**Key Messages from the  
North Wales Safeguarding Childrens Board  
May 2018**

- **Presentation on North Wales Locality Review, from Dave Jolly, North Wales Police** the report has been shared via the community safety agenda with the Chief Executives, and from there the Chief Executives are expected to cascade the report into their organisations.
- **Presentation on Domestic Homicide Review, by Sue Maskell;** The Domestic Homicide Review examined the circumstances surrounding the death of Marie (pseudonym). Marie lived in a small rural village in North Wales. Marie was murdered in September 2014 by a man she had recently met online. Learning from the review and areas for improvement in practice were discussed.
- **Child Practice Reviews –** The group agreed to sign off three CPR Action Plans; NWSCB CPR 1 Flintshire, NWSCB CPR 2 Flintshire, NWSCB CPR Gwynedd.

The action plans demonstrated the work that has taken place across the region in relation to:

- Pre-birth Assessments
  - Placement with Parents
- **Annual Partner Agency Reports -** presentations were given by:
    - North Wales Police
    - Probation
    - Ynys Mon CC
  - **Findings of Safeguarding Training Needs Analysis presented by Mark Rowley –** the recommendations were approved by the board; the regional safeguarding training and workforce group will report back to the board within the next 12 months to report back on progress
