Parents/Professionals Protect!

Informal 2 hour sessions to raise awareness and information for adults on the facts around child sexual abuse and our responsibility to prevent it, with information tailored to the needs of participants age/stage of children.

Session Content includes:

- Understanding abuser behaviour
- How and why people sexual abuse children
- Understanding the greater vulnerability of children with additional needs
- The barrier to identifying harmful behaviour and how to overcome them
- Positive actions adults can take to prevent child sexual abuse

Parents Protect! for Children with Additional Needs

Informal 2 hour sessions to raise awareness and information for parents on the facts around child sexual abuse and our responsibility to prevent it, with information tailored to the needs of children with additional needs.

Session Content includes:

- Understanding abuser behaviour
- How and why people sexual abuse children
- Understanding the greater vulnerability of children with additional needs
- The barrier to identifying harmful behaviour and how to overcome them
- Positive actions adults can take to prevent child sexual abuse

Internet Safety! – Keeping children safe online

Informal 2 hour sessions to educate and build confidence in participants on issues around internet safety and protecting children and young people from abuse online, with information tailored to the needs of children with additional needs.

Session Content includes:

- Discussion about the positive and negative uses of the internet
- How people use the internet to abuse children
- Issues around online grooming, sexting, cyberbullying and viewing illegal images of children
- Positive preventative actions to take to protect children from online abuse.

Child Sexual Exploitation Prevention Awareness

Informal 2 hour sessions to increase knowledge and understanding of how child sexual exploitation can happen, what the risk to children and young people are and what action can be taken. Crucially, we give parents and carers the confidence to seek help and take action if they need to.

Session Content includes:

- The facts about sexual abuse and exploitation and how it can happen
- How abusers groom their victims
- Why victims may not talk about what is happening
- Spotting signs in a child's behaviour
- Positive preventative actions to take to protect children and young people from exploitation
- Acting on concerns, giving sources of information, support or advice
