KEY MESSAGES

Thursday 20th September 2018

- The Board has been highly commended at the Social Care Accolades around the work done in North Wales regarding the development and implementation of a Self-Neglect protocol.
- A Training Needs Analysis has been undertaken by the joint Workforce Development and Training Group which highlighted issues around basic awareness and basic safeguarding training across the region.
The recommendations of the report were accepted and supported by the Board.
- The North Wales Safeguarding Board and North Wales Police held a joint launch of the Herbert Missing Persons Protocol at Conwy Business Centre, this generated a lot of media interest and was very well attended. The launch was opened by the Chair of the Board and Chief Constable Gareth Pritchard, feedback from the event was received at Board.
- Highlight reports were received from the subgroups of the Board which highlighted any issues being experienced within practice and gave updates on the progress of the groups against their work programmes.
- The Board was joined by 3 external advisers/facilitators, who will be working with the Board regarding key issues.
