Thursday 28th November 2018

- An overview of the work currently being undertaken by the North Wales Anti Modern Slavery Group was presented by their Chair Annwen Morgan, Isle of Anglesey Council. Discussions took place around referral pathways, awareness raising, training and the links between the Group and the Regional Safeguarding Boards. The group has developed to become more strategic, ensuring a better understanding of every partner's responsibility in this important area.
- Work that had been undertaken on behalf of the Board in response to the HASCAS and Ockenden Report into Tawelfan has been completed and an update from BCUHB was given in relation to the progress in relation to the recommendations from those reports.
- Feedback from the activities and events that took place during National Safeguarding Week was given. The Exploitation Conference was very well attended and comments received from attendees indicated it was well received and thought provoking. Various workshops were also well attended including APR/CPR Key themes workshop with a presentation from Michael Preston Shoot, Eleri Lloyd Burns and Ruth Ingham – again feedback was very positive.
- Launch of the NWSB Safeguarding Video – See Something, Say Something took place at the conference. It can be viewed on the NWSB website and is available for download.
- Following the presentation of the NW Training Needs Analysis at the last meeting, and update was received regarding the proposal to develop a regional learning and development framework across agencies.
