KEY MESSAGES

From meeting held on

Thursday 14th March 2019

- All Wales Strategic Sport Safeguarding Partnership presented to Board. The NSPCC Child Protection Support Unit and Ann Craft Trust working in partnership with Sport Wales to support organisations to meet safeguarding responsibilities. There is a new 'Sport Safeguarding Hub' for NGB's and Statutory Agencies.
- The 2019/20 Business Plan was presented for discussion and agreement. A Joint plan for NWSAB and NWSCB with 2 shared priorities – Exploitation and Domestic Abuse and a 3rd Priority for NWSAB is Adult at Risk.
- Board discussions took place around the HIW Special Review regarding Abertawe Bro Morgannwg University Health Board focused on the following issues:
 - Staff recruitment and employment.
 - Incident reporting.
 - Adult safeguarding.
 - Governance and culture.
- A report was received from National Independent Safeguarding Board. Members agreed that having the support of NISB at Board was invaluable and Chair hopes to re-establish relationships with them in the future.
