Key Messages

From the
Meeting held on Wednesday 26th May 2021

- Presentation received from Deprivation of Liberty Standards leads around the transition from DoLS to Liberty Protection safeguards and the challenges that this is posing. The Workforce Development and Training Group will be working with Social Care Wales to deliver the training in the region. The Liberty Protection Safeguards are planned to come into force in April 2022. The NWSB Business Plan will be updated to reflect the work package that needs to take place.
- An update was received by the Board from all agencies in regards to the ongoing safeguarding activity during the Covid-19 pandemic, with much improved situation being reported and no significant issues.
- North Wales Police are highlighting issues around cybercrime, in particular romance and financial crimes are on the increase in the region. The NWSB website will be refreshing its messages around scams and cybercrime.
- The Board is awaiting publication of a thematic review that was commissioned by the Independent Safeguarding Board in Wales around themes emanating from Adult Practice Reviews. The report will be published on the NWSB website when available.
