BACKGROUND

Create a single review process where a multi-agency approach is required, incorporating the following review processes Adult Practice Review; Child Practice Review; Domestic Homicide Review; Mental health Homicide Review; Offensive Weapon Homicide Review. The final report is then used to inform professional practice via the Wales Safeguarding Repository.

PROGRESS TO DATE

- The SUSR Team will present the SUSR Statutory Guidance at the next Steering Group meeting. This will include any amendments made as a result of the pre-consultation engagement sessions
- The content for the SUSR Webpage has been developed. This will be housed on the Welsh Government website. This platform will also include links to the SUSR Statutory Guidance, consultation information, the SUSR Toolkit and other helpful templates.

SUSR STATUTORY GUIDANCE

- Fradd Consultancy has been commissioned to carry out engagement sessions throughout the consultation period. The pre-consultation engagement sessions will be held on the 18th, 19th and 20th October (there will be a morning and afternoon session on each date). Please use the email address above to indicate which session you would like to attend.
- The SUSR team have sent the final draft of the guidance to be translated into Welsh, and an Easy Read version is currently being developed.

POLICY & PROCESS

- A final draft of the SUSR Report template has been created. The WSR team have provided comments and feedback which have helped to ensure that the template is compatible with the WSR.

OFFENSIVE WEAPON HOMICIDE

- Preparations and considerations for the next Offensive Weapon Homicide Review Task and Finish group are underway. This group will soon be presented with a tabletop exercise which considers the Welsh SUSR/OWHR pilot.

LEARNING & TRAINING

- A meeting with one of the Regional Safeguarding Boards was held discuss a way forward for the creation of the SUSR Training materials. Further research into the most suitable approach will now be conducted.

LEGAL & GOVERNANCE

- Work continues to produce a Joint data controller agreement between Cardiff University and Welsh Government for the Wales Safeguarding Repository.

MENTAL HEALTH HOMICIDE

- The Mental Health Homicide Task and Finish Group will continue discussions to ensure that the Mental Health Homicide requirements fit within the SUSR process.

WALES SAFEGUARDING REPOSITORY

- The WSR team have been working with Geldards to understand the requirements of the User Agreement for the WSR.
